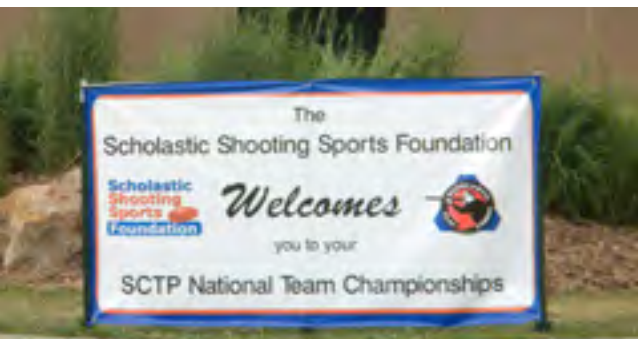

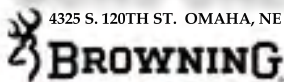

Caledon Shotguns

For Kids

magazine does for the junior shooters out there and hope that I can continue to help promote shooting for the future. About six months ago I sent you a pair of FAUSTI Caledon Over and Under (O/U) shotguns to try out: a 12-gauge and a Youth Model 20-gauge. I have since shot both many times and have really enjoyed doing so. The standard 12-gauge model features a 14-1/2" length of pull, automatic ejectors, metallic bead, and a single breakable trigger. The highest quality turks walnut is meticulously shaped, oiled, and hand polished to perfection. All models are offered in a 28", 28" or 30" barrel. The 12-gauge model weighs 7.25 pounds, while the 20-gauge weighs a modest 6.3 pounds. The Caledon performs well on sporting days courses and carries well in the field. Many classic and timeless qualities make the Caledon unique among others in the field. The Youth Caledon has a barrel length of 28" x 14-1/2" length of pull and weighs only

In the fall, I used both shotguns for hunting a variety of

hatch and very steep. The birds like it where they think they are safe from hunters, which is many miles away from easy access. I used the 12-gauge and absolutely loved it! It was great for the difficult terrain. When you hike all day long and use all your energy to get to where you want to be (which is on top of the birds), you want your gun to perform flawlessly. The FAUSTI passed with flying colors.

Ease of assembly: The two FAUSTIs were a snap to put together and came apart easily. Both had a very right action. A right action is important if you want your gun to last a long time, which these guns will.

How it felt in my hands: The guns felt great in my hands, and I really enjoyed shooting them both. The 12-gauge fit me perfectly and shot right where I wanted it to. It was really smooth to shoot and easy to swing at a moving bird or a target. The barrel was just long enough that you wouldn't miss something

because short enough that it could be swung smoothly to get a fast-moving object. The weight was just right. It was nice to carry around all day when you're hunting. You wouldn't be too tired to make it count. The 20-gauge was also fun to shoot. It felt like I was shooting a target that was just a little bit further from me but not too far that I couldn't see it. It was lightweight and easy to shoot fast-moving birds because of this. I had a blast shooting both guns, and both felt great.

Sights: Each gun had a large brass bead at the end of its top barrel which was great. You could see birds and targets with great ease. The field of vision was enough that you could see where you were shooting and the target at the same time. I would not change the sight picture at all.

Recall: The recall was noticeable but manageable. Both light target loads and heavy game loads were fine to shoot through the gun, and with the interchangeable choke tubes, you could adjust the pattern of the gun if you wanted to.

Safety: The guns had a safety on the top of the receiver. It was a mechanical safety so you have to turn it off every time you load the gun. This was great for bird hunting, as what these guns are really made for, but not so much for shooting clay targets. The safety was easy to get to and turn off when it was time to shoot.

These guns were great, and I would not change anything on either of them. They were awesome in every aspect, and I had a blast trying them out!

Thanks again, Junior Shooters, for allowing me to write this article for you.

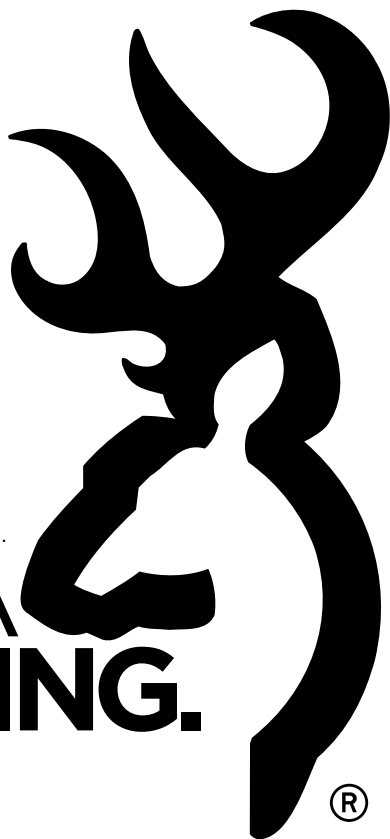

ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES FOR SCTP & SASP:

1. Current ATA, NSCA, NSSA, USA Shooting and SASP rules, as well as rules in this program and any match or National Director's bulletins posted on this range, govern this match.
2. All participating athletes and coaches must be registered and fully paid with the SSSF before competing. Event registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. For SCTP and SASP, all reservations will be done electronically through the team login at www.sssfonline.org.
3. All ammunition and practice rounds are the responsibility of the participant.
4. Alcohol/illegal or individually non-prescribed drugs and firearms do not mix. Alcohol and other illegal substances are strictly forbidden by the SSSF during this event. Further, any person who is found to be in possession of, or under the influence of, alcohol or drugs while using, cleaning, maintaining, inspecting, or otherwise handling their shotgun or any other firearm at any time will be immediately disqualified from the entire event and asked to leave without refund.
5. Safe gun handling and appropriate shooting attire are required. Flip-flops and open-toed shoes are prohibited. No tank tops, mid-drift tops or shorts above mid-thigh are allowed.
Reprimands will be issued based on violation and could ultimately mean disqualification from the tournament.
6. **Hat shooting is strictly prohibited during competition.** Once all competition has been completed, hat shooting may occur 1) ONLY after receiving permission from the tournament director or staff member and 2) under the supervision of a state advisor or coach. Any competitor who participates in hat shooting outside of both of these conditions will be immediately disqualified and asked to leave the competition without refund.
7. All shooters must sign the score sheet (next to the score total) before leaving the range.
8. Use of any tobacco product by anyone under the age of 18 is against Ohio State Law, and any use of tobacco product by an SCTP/SASP participant under the age of 18 is against SSSF guidelines. Participating in the use of tobacco products can be grounds for disqualification from the tournament.
9. Any athlete or adult disqualified from the tournament will not receive a refund of any tournament fees, game fees, practice fees or any other funds paid to SSSF or its agents.
10. 1-5 Place ties in the Individual Skeet & Trap events will be broken by long run back and then long run front. Sporting Clays ties will be broken by three pre-designated tie-breaker stations. SASP ties will be broken per rule book. If a tie occurs for final ranking, the In & Out stage score will be used as the tie-breaker. If that does not break the tie, the fastest single run of that stage will be used as the tie-breaker. If still needed, the second and third run will be used as the tie breaker.

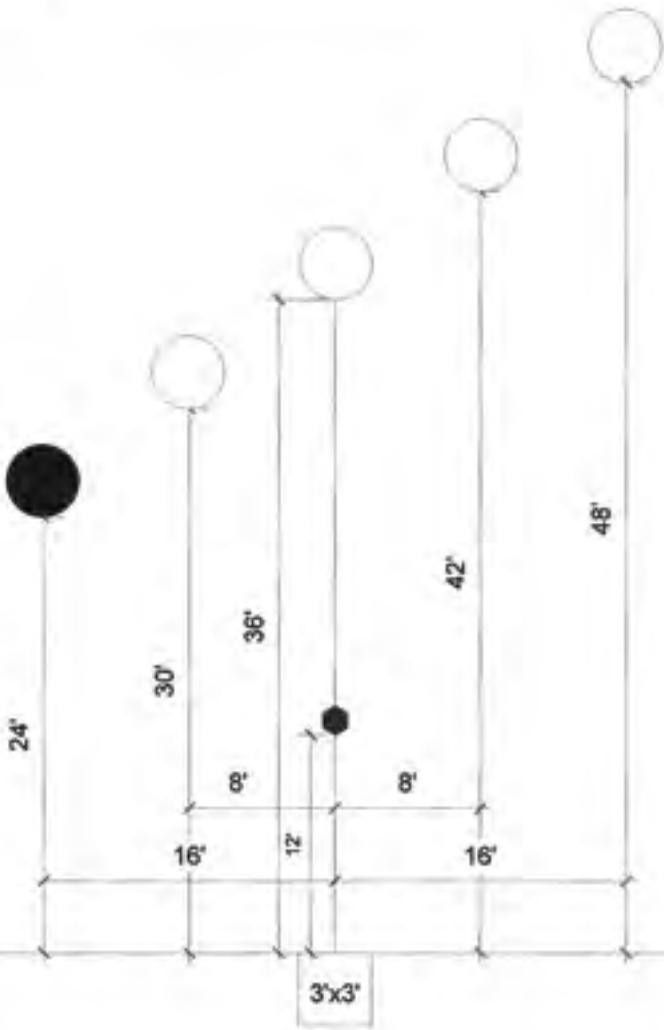
