

 - Rookie/Intermediate (8th Grade and under. Rookie, Intermediate Entry, & Intermediate Advanced categories combined.) 1st and 2nd (Individual Buckles and Squad Medals)
 - Senior Junior Varsity (1st year of participation in Grades 9 12) 1st and 2nd (Individual Buckles and Squad Medals)
 - Senior Varsity (After 1st year of participation in Grades 9 12) 1st and 2nd (Individual Buckles and Squad Medals)
 - Open (Competitive squad of athletes from a single team with multiple classifications. This division does not include college athletes.) 1st and 2nd (Squad Medals)
 - College (Tentative depending on participation) 1st and 2nd (Individual Medels and Squad -Medals)
- ENDOWMENT MONEY AWARDS: The top three teams will be awarded endowment money for their MidwayUSA Foundation Endowment Account based on the combined score of the team's top five shooters (excluding college athletes), regardless of category or gender.
 - Champion \$3,000, Runner-Up \$2,000, Third Place \$1,000
- Individual and Squad Categories are based on grade. For purposes of determining an Athlete's eligibility for the SCTP season, the grade level he or she entered in the Fall School Semester is the one that will be used for assignment to an SCTP Division.
- Only full squads of three (3) will qualify for the squad awards.
- Please be mindful of the time your shooters take between rounds.
- A designated coach must accompany each squad to assist shooters with any gun malfunctions. Problems that cannot be resolved in a timely manner will need to be made up at the practice field.

- There will be limited seating so please encourage your families to bring chairs along with them.
