# What is Trap Madness?

Virtual Tournament. Limited to 16 squads, first come, first served.

## Who can participate?

Shooters 12th grade and below, two squad limit per team.

### Why?

To promote trapshooting fun and serious practice.

# What does it Cost to participate?

Nothing, participation in Trap Madness is completely free!

#### What do we shoot?

5-person squad shooting 1 round of 16-yard trap for record score.

#### When is it?

Beginning mid-April and continuing as long as you win your bracket.

# What are the prizes?

Winning squad receives trophy at the PA SCTP/AIM School Shoot.

#### What is the schedule?

Report scores by the date listed for each round:

- First round no later than April 22nd
- Elite 8 round no later than May 6th
- Final 4 round no later than May 20th
- Two remaining squads no later than June 3rd

## **Trap Madness Details**

- To register email the following info to <u>payouthclays@gmail.com</u> by April 15, 2018.
   (no late registrations accepted)
  - o Squad Name
  - o Names of 5 shooters per squad
  - o Coaches Name, Email & Phone#
- Teams are limited to 2 squads.
- Squad must keep the 5 named shooters throughout the tournament. Substitution only if a squad member leaves your program.
- Squads will be placed in bracket by random drawing.
- In the designated time period, shoot a "round for record", 5 shooters times 25 shots equal 125 possible score.
- Shoot your first round no later than April 22, 2018. Email the score to payouthclays@gmail.com no later than the listed dates. Squad dropped if you fail to report score on time.
- Tied scores will be broken by coin flip.
- Coaches; play fair, be ethical, honor the sport. You must designate the "round for record" before the squad shoots that round.
- Check the "PA Scholastic Clay Target
   Program" Facebook page the following
   Monday to see if you're squad is still in the tournament. If so, shoot and report another "round for record" within the next time period.
