Top Team Award:

Champion, Runner-Up, Third Place \$10,000, \$5,000, and \$3,000 of endowment money paid to the top three teams.

Top College Award:

Champion, Runner Up \$5,000 and \$2,000 of endowment money paid to the top two teams.

HOA AWARDS*

All team events that include multiple disciplines or divisions will be based on a point system for all places. Individual results will be used to compile points. First Place awards will receive 10 points, Second Place awards will receive 9 points, Third Place awards will receive 8 points, Fourth Place awards will receive 7 points, Fifth Place awards will receive 6 point, Sixth Place awards will receive 5 points, Seventh Place awards will receive 4 points, Eight Place awards will receive 3 points, Ninth Place awards will receive 2 points, and Tenth Place awards will receive 1 point. First, Second, and Third place team is based on total points earned. Both Open and Ladies Divisions earn points. All ties for points will be broken by long run tie breaker.
